

Issue:

Signs

Continue to monitor large unattractive signs along Route 702.

Recommendations:

- Need several more "Critical Areas" signs in the lower Back River Neck area.
- All signs below Cape May Rd. that are not public service, non-profit should be rustic as befits a rural, natural area.
- Environmentally sensitive directional signs for businesses located on roads off of Back River Neck Rd. should be permitted.
- Removal of all signs not in compliance with county regulations.
- "No Dumping/No Littering" signs should be posted throughout the area. Educational programs about littering and dumping of refuse should be continued as a cooperative effort between the county and the community.
- Continue enforcement of removal of all commercial signs along Route 702 in compliance with federal road standards.
- Produce stand signs should be neat, legible and maintained then removed after the season ends.
- Temporary signs (party, showers) should be removed promptly after the events are over.
